He died on Jan 02, 1995 in Miami, FL (Liver canceralcoholism).

Notes for Lorna Margaret Rainbow:

In 1949 Voter Records, Lorna is living at 31 Glyn Mansions, Fulham, London with her mother Lorna Pearl Rainbow, father Kenneth Rainbow and aunt Phyllis Rainbow.

In 1951 Voter Records, Lorna is living with her parents, aunt Phyllis Rainbow, and brother Geoffrey at 31 Glyn Mansions, Fulham, London.

Robert Howard Arnold served in the military between Jul 09, 1945-1947 (I have Selective Service Induction; military ID; promotion info; letters (but no;discharge info)/Sgt., US Army Serial #42156869).

Notes for Robert Howard Arnold: Lived with Tom Metzger for 20+ years

Robert Howard Arnold and Lorna Margaret Rainbow were divorced (Y).

He died on May 26, 1958 in Huddersfield, England (Age: 69). He married **Lorna Pearl Dawson**, daughter of Charles James Dawson and Ellen Cooper on Mar 23, 1915 in Willesden, Middlesex, England.
3. **Lorna Pearl Dawson**, daughter of Charles James Dawson and Ellen Cooper was born on Mar 11, 1885 in Islington, London, United Kingdom. She died on Mar 26, 1970 in Cambridge, Cambridgeshire, England (Age: 85).

Kenneth Wallace Rainbow served in the military between 1914-1920 in Europe. He served in the military on Jan 18, 1917. He was buried in 1958 (?).

Notes for Kenneth Wallace Rainbow:

RNVR 1908; Naval Division 1914 (Nieuwpoort & Ypres).

Joined Pioneer Corps in Liverpool during 1940-45;

worked in the Air Ministry until his retirement in 1955.

Lived at 2 Prospect Place Ashley Lane Lymington at time of his death in 1958.

Lorna Pearl Dawson was buried in 1970 (?).

Notes for Lorna Pearl Dawson:

Made a pact with her siblings to stay single, and lived with them until her marriage

Worked for the Trustee Savings Bank until her marriage.

He married **Annie Elizabeth Wallis**, daughter of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard in 1886 in Reading, Berkshire, England (Based on BMD index).
5. **Annie Elizabeth Wallis**, daughter of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard was born on Mar 23, 1852 in Kingston, Surrey, England. She died on Apr 05, 1940 in Chiddingfold, Surrey, England (Age: 88).

William Charles Rainbow was buried in 1894 in Richmond, St Mary Magdalene, Surrey, England (Age: 47 Family tradition holds there may have been a problem about his legacy (will)).

I can find no record of his will in probate records from 1894-1897).

Annie Elizabeth Wallis was buried about Apr 1940 in Grayswood, Surrey, England (All Saints Church Cemetery).

Notes for Annie Elizabeth Wallis:

Her grave is at Grayswood.

Annie Elizabeth Wallis and William Charles Rainbow had the following children:

- i. Horace Arthur Rainbow, son of William Charles Rainbow and Annie Elizabeth Wallis was born in 1886 in Reading, Berkshire, England (?). He died on Oct 10, 1909 in Kingston Upon Thames, Surrey, England (Suicide while depressed).

Horace Arthur Rainbow was buried in 1910 (?).

Notes for Horace Arthur Rainbow:

The golden boy of the family. Although he had no formal training, he joined an architect's firm as a draftsman and did well. At the age of 21 he submitted a personal entry for the design of County Hall and received 3rd prize.

The official story of his death is that had a nervous breakdown but made a good recovery. He then caught scarlet fever, and became depressed, and took his own life while suffering from depression. His mother found him in the kitchen at home in a pool of blood.

- iii. Phyllis Margaret Rainbow, daughter of William Charles Rainbow and Annie Elizabeth Wallis was born on Jun 28, 1891 in Woodley, Berkshire, England ((Woodley/Yately?), Hants., England). She died on Jul 14, 1972 in Cambridge, Cambridgeshire, England (Pneumonia following series of strokes).

Phyllis Margaret Rainbow was buried in 1972 in Cambridge, Cambridgeshire, England.

Notes for Phyllis Margaret Rainbow: Worked for Gas Light & Coke (later NTGB); kept house for Lorna Arnold until stroke in 1963.

1945 Electoral Rolls 45 Gordon Place, London. Lorna Rainbow (niece) lived at same address.

1946. Same address, Lorna no longer listed with her.

1947 Electoral Rolls. Living at 31 Glyn Mansions with brother Kenneth Rainbow and his wife Lorna Pearl.
Lived with each of her nieces until her death.

6. **Charles James Dawson**, son of Unknown Dawson was born in Jan 1840 in Cheltenham, Gloucestershire, United Kingdom. He died in 1904. He married **Ellen Cooper**, daughter of William Cooper and Sarah Cooper on May 29, 1884 in Mildmay Grove St Jude, England; described as Widower and Schoolmaster (St. Jude's Church, Islington, England).
7. **Ellen Cooper**, daughter of William Cooper and Sarah Cooper was born about 1849 in Shrewsbury; St Mary. She died in 1894.

8. **Elisha Rainbow**, son of Edward Rainbow and Sarah Lokier was born on Jan 11, 1804 in Chelsea, London, Middlesex, England (Dwelling: Kew Bridge Road 54 Census Place: Ealing, Middlesex, England;Source: FHL Film 1341327 PRO Ref RG11 Piece 1348 Folio;85 Page 15;Marr Age Sex Birthplace;Elisha RAINBOW W 77 M Middlesex, England;Rel:). He died in Jun 1886 in Brentford, Middlesex, United Kingdom (Per death records/Brentford, Age: 82). He married **Martha Powell**, daughter of Paul Powell and Elizabeth Tuther date Unknown.
9. **Martha Powell**, daughter of Paul Powell and Elizabeth Tuther was born on Nov 30, 1801 in Richmond, Surrey, England. She died before 1881.

Elisha Rainbow was buried on Jun 29, 1886 in Richmond, St Mary Magdalene, Surrey, England (Age: 82).

Notes for Elisha Rainbow:

54, Kew Bridge Road Ealing Middx.

At the time of his daughter Emily's birth in 1826, listed as a hatter. Living in Chelsea, St Luke's Parish.

1839 Directory of Richmond, Surrey, listed as a Hatter on George St.

In 1851, Directory of Richmond, Surrery, listed as a hat manufacturer on George St.

In 1863 and 1864, he lives in Richmond on George St, but owns property in Churchill Rd, Westminster, London. He votes in Westminster for that reason.

1867, Post Office Directory, listed as living at 60 Brewer's Lane, Richmond, and his occupation is hat manufacturer

1882, listed as living at 54 Kew Bridge Road, Brentford.

Family lore is that the Rainbows came from the north of England - or else from East London.

Elisha Rainbow may have also been known as Ellis Rainbow. He (or his father, or his father-in-law) may have held aldermanic rank.

In the 1881 census Elisha is a widower, living with daughters Emily and Louisa in Ealing.

Notes for Martha Powell:

1841 and 1851 census, lives with parents. Listed as dressmaker. Listed as being born in Richmond, Surrey in 1851 census.

Family lore is that there was a connection to the Tudors through Powell, probably Welsh fancy, but possible substantive.

Martha Powell and Elisha Rainbow had the following children:

- i. Emily Eliza Rainbow, daughter of Elisha Rainbow and Martha Powell was born in Sep 1826 in Chelsea St Luke, England. She died on Feb 05, 1907 in Brentford, Middlesex, United Kingdom (Age: 80. In the probate record, her estate was more than 4500 pounds. Left to her sister and brother in law the Loxleys.).
- ii. Louisa Rainbow, daughter of Elisha Rainbow and Martha Powell was born on Oct 26, 1828 in Richmond, Surrey, England. She died on Nov 26, 1921 in Brentford, Middlesex, England (Left an estate of over 8000 pounds.).

Notes for Louisa Rainbow:

Lorna Arnold (Rainbow) remembers visiting her in about 1920. She recalls "an opulent house, a forbidding old lady". She knew her as "old Aunt Lou".

- iii. Henry Powell Rainbow, son of Elisha Rainbow and Martha Powell was born about 1835 in Richmond, Surrey, England. He died on Nov 12, 1890 in Surrey, England.
- iv. Robert Rainbow, son of Elisha Rainbow and Martha Powell was born on Jul 23, 1837 in Richmond St Mary, England. He died on Mar 16, 1898 in Surrey, England (Age: 60). He married Unknown date Unknown. She was born date Unknown in Frome, Somerset, England. She died date Unknown.
- v. Edward Ellis Rainbow, son of Elisha Rainbow and Martha Powell was born on Nov 17, 1840 in Richmond, England.
4. vi. William Charles Rainbow, son of Elisha Rainbow and Martha Powell was born about 1847 in Richmond, Surrey, England. He died on Sep 15, 1894 in Kew, England (Age: 47). He married Annie Elizabeth Wallis, daughter of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard in 1886 in Reading, Berkshire, England (Based on BMD index). She was born on Mar 23, 1852 in Kingston, Surrey, England. She married John Loxley, son of Henry Loxley and Mary Ann Carter on Nov 14, 1867 in Balham St Mary, England. He was born about 1837 in Horsham, Sussex, England. He died on May 27, 1904 in Middlesex, England (Living in Ealing at time of death. Estate over 10,000 pounds.).

Notes for John Loxley:

Per FTW online, Loxley is a relatively rare name - Birmingham, or Bidford-on-Avon in Warwickshire.

10. **James Wallis**, son of Wallis and <No name> was born before 1830 (?). He died after 1858 (?). He married **Ellen Goddard** date Unknown (?).

11. **Ellen Goddard** was born before 1830 in ?Amberley Surrey. She died after 1858 (?). James Wallis was buried date Unknown (?).

Notes for James Wallis:

By one account, an alcoholic who provided ill for his large family.

Ellen Goddard was buried date Unknown (?).

Notes for Ellen Goddard:

Lorna never met her. Born and raised at Amberley Wildbrooks, near Arundel

Ellen Goddard and James Wallis had the following children:

- i. Harry Wallis, son of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard was born about 1849. He died after 1939. He married Katherine Ford about 1873 in ?Twickenham. She was born about 1850. She died after 1933.

Notes for Harry Wallis:

"Harry married K.F. & Lived at Twickenham. His diamond wedding & 90th birthday were great occasions which I hardly remember."
(GAFR letter)

He died on Sep 15, 1894 in Kew, England (Age: 47).
- iii. Emily Wallis, daughter of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard was born date Unknown. She died date Unknown in USA.

Notes for Emily Wallis:

Unmarried, went to America ("it seems the family were glad she went").

[Note that Rosemary thinks Emily married Tom Shrimpton - see Louise.]

- iv. Louise Wallis, daughter of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard was born date Unknown. She died date Unknown in New Zealand (In childbirth?). She married Tom Shrimpton date Unknown. He was born date Unknown. He died date Unknown.

Notes for Louise Wallis:

"Louise married Tom Shrimpton and had 3 children." However according to Rosemary, it was Emily that married Tom. (Lorna confirms it was Louise.)

- v. Adelaide Wallis, daughter of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard was born about 1858. She died date Unknown. She married Ludwig Hermes date Unknown. He was born date Unknown. He died date Unknown. She married Gustav Carol date Unknown. He was born date Unknown. He died date Unknown.

Notes for Adelaide Wallis:

Her husbands were colleagues. She had 3 children by her 1st who were loyally brought up by the 2nd. Her 80th birthday (c.1938) was a big occasion.

- vi. Arthur Wallis, son of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard was born date Unknown. He married May Unknown.
 - vii. Herbert Wallis, son of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard was born date Unknown.
 - viii. Cornelius Wallis, son of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard was born date Unknown.
 - ix. E. W. Wallis, son of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard was born in 1855.
 - x. Wallis, son of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard was born date Unknown.
 - xi. Walter Wallis, son of James Wallis and Ellen Goddard was born date Unknown. He died date Unknown. He married Eger date Unknown. She was born date Unknown. She died date Unknown.
12. **Unknown Dawson** was born date Unknown. He died date Unknown. He married an unknown spouse date Unknown.

He married **Sarah Lokier**, daughter of John Lokier and Mary Lokier on Dec 21, 1808 in Bloomsbury St George, England.
17. **Sarah Lokier**, daughter of John Lokier and Mary Lokier was born in Jun 1783 in Chelsea, Middlesex, England (Baptised in St Luke's Chelsea). She died about 1853 (Age: 69).

Sarah Lokier was buried on Nov 10, 1853 (Age: 69). She was employed as a Grocer From Post Office Directory in 38 Manor St Chelsea.

Sarah Lokier and Edward Rainbow had the following children:

 - iii. Ephraim Rainbow was born on Dec 18, 1805 in Chelsea St Luke, England. He died on Nov 02, 1876 in Middlesex, England. He married Elizabeth Rainbow. She was born about 1811 in Chelsea, London, Middlesex, England.
18. **Paul Powell** was born about 1773 in Tretire, Hertfordshire, England. He died in Mar 1860 in Richmond, Surrey, United Kingdom. He married **Elizabeth Tuther** on Dec 29, 1800 in Piccadilly St James, England.
 19. **Elizabeth Tuther** was born about 1765 in Bewsley, Worcestershire, England.

Paul Powell was employed as a Alderman in 1841 in Richmond, Surrey, England. He was buried on Mar 27, 1860 in Richmond, St Mary Magdalene, Surrey, England (This date makes sense, but he does die in an Almshouse, which sounds odd if he was once an alderman).

Notes for Paul Powell:

In 1851 census, listed as alderman and shoemaker Occupation Notes:

Listed in 1841 census as alderman.

Elizabeth Tuther and Paul Powell had the following children:

There is no record of William Thomas Rainbow's baptism but these are his parents The other children are named similarly and the related members are buried in the same vault at St. James Garlickhithe in London. Additionally a Lucy Rainbow (WTR's wife to be) was a witness at Joseph's marriage on April 16th, 1800. See also the details of the Old Bailey Proceedings to follow which are pretty conclusive.

Apprenticed to Higgins Eden - a Dyer - July 7, 1762. Son of Edward Rainbow, late of Turnham Green (Chiswick) Maltman.

The Dyer's Company - Freedom Registers: "6 Sepr 1769 Edward Rainbow Son of Edward Rainbow who was bound an apprentice to Higgins Eden by Indenture dated 7 July 1762 is this day sworn & made free accordingly. Edwd Rainbow at Mr. Park's Maid Lane Garlick Hill 2 shillings". (Living with his father-in-law?).

College Hill comes out of St. Thomas Apostles, falls into Thames street: a place well built, and inhabited by Merchants and others. On the West side is Maiden lane, which crosseth New Queens street, and falls into Garlick Hill by St. James Garlick Hithe Church. Out of this Lane is a passage into Thames street, and another into Maiden head Court which is but ordinary...John Strype's A Survey of the Cities of London and Westminster (1720)

Bankrupt late 1775 "Edw. Rainbow of Queen Street, Cheapside". Town and Country Magazine or Universal Repository of Knowledge, Instruction and Entertainment, Vol. VIII for the year 1776, January.

Land and Tax Records show a likely Edward Rainbow as: 1774-5 Tower; 1776, 1781-1784 Vintry; 1789 Vintry; 1792 Vintry; 1793 Portsoken; 1794 Vintry; 1796 Tower; 1797-98 Vintry; 1800 Portsoken; 1804 Bishopsgate; 1805, 1807 Southwark St. Olave.

On February 22, 1781, a John Crocker testified at the Old Bailey in the trial for theft of Patrick Norris aka Norton: "I am a silk-dyer, and am in partnership with Edward Rainbow".

An Edward Rainbow was a member of the London Jury of the Old Bailey proceedings starting April 10, 1782.

1785 Bailey's Directory: Rainbow, Edw., Dyer, 32 Queen St, Upper Thames St.

1790 Bailey's Directory: Rainbow, Edward, silk dyer, 32 Queen St, Cheapside. This entry is consistently the same in 1794 Wakefield, 1795 Boyles, 1796 McCulloch, 1800 Kent's (silkman) & Boyles City Companion.

1798 Land Tax Redemption refers to Edward Rainbow, Vintry Ward (near St. James Garlickhythe and Queenhithe).

On September 17, 1800, Edward Rainbow (age 55) and his son, Wiliam Thomas Rainbow, were indicted for feloniously receiving, on July 11, 1800, a considerable amount of stolen silk for the sum of 200 pounds. In the end, Edward was convicted and sentenced to deportation for 14 years, whereas the thieves were sentenced to death. W.T.Rainbow was acquitted. During the course of the testimony, the following details were mentioned:

W.T.Rainbow lived at 24 College Hill, Cheapside, in a house his father had taken for him on his recent marriage

One of the witnesses lived at 31 Queen St, Cheapside, next door to Edward Rainbow.

Edward's wife had been injured (run over) the day before the incident.

WTR testified he had been married 3 month's "last Monday" which would make it June 15, 1800. (Actually June 9)

Edward claimed he believed the silk smuggled but not stolen. WTR testified that he was his father's servant only, and that his father "had no idea of this transaction being illegal".

As per Crimnal Registers 1791-1892, Edward was pardoned July 24, 1801. He is described as age 55, 5'6", fair complect, grey hair, grey eyes.

1801 & 1802 Kent's Directory shows W.T.Rainbow at the same site. By 1804, a G.Baldwin, paper warehouse, is in this location.

1811 Directory shows Edw. Rainbow, mercer, at 30 Aldgate High Street.

Is the burial the correct Edward? The age matches pretty well ... Death record (age 82) indicates a 1745 birth which matches Edward's age at the time of the trial. At time of death likely residing with his son Edward and his wife Sarah.

Mary Park was buried on Oct 23, 1807 in St James Garlickhithe, London, England.

Mary Park and Edward Rainbow had the following children:
